

SLAA AUSTRALIA WEB SITE CONTENT PROTOCOL

1. It is acknowledged that both Sydney & Melbourne Intergroups have approved the initial web site content.
2. The Web Site Co-ordinator ("WSC") may make the following additions and alterations to the site at his or her discretion:
 - 2.1 on the News page, post minutes of Intergroup meetings (both Intergroups have already given approval for this);
 - 2.2 on the News page, post announcements as requested;
 - 2.3 on the News page, post links to or copies of announcements & other new items posted by Fellowship Wide Services on its web site;
 - 2.4 on the Meetings page, make changes advised at Intergroup or to the Meetings List Co-ordinator, provided the relevant meeting's group conscience has approved its listing on the site;
 - 2.5 on the Literature Orders page, changes requested by the Literature Person;
 - 2.6 editorial corrections – being minor changes or corrections - as required.
3. Any member of either Intergroup, including the WSC, may recommend persons to be approached to write for the Stories of Hope and Recovery page. On approval by the relevant Intergroup, it is the responsibility of the WSC to liaise with that person to complete their story. On completion, the WSC may post the story on the web site unless he or she has any concerns, in which case he or she should put the story and those concerns to the relevant Intergroup.
4. Other content changes may not be made without the approval of both Intergroups.
